

Camasrock New Puppy Questionnaire

Please honestly ask yourself the following questions.

- *Are you ready for another 'baby' family member and to dedicate 12-15 years to caring for a dog? Are all family members in agreement?*
- *Can you afford to give a dog quality care? (vet bills, food bills, boarding fees, training classes, etc)*
- *Do you have the time and patience to spend on training and exercising a dog and will a committed adult be in charge?*
- *Have you owned a Labrador before and are you familiar with their energy levels, their enthusiasm and need for social contact? Is a Labrador the right dog for your lifestyle and location?*

If you are ready to welcome a puppy into your home, please provide the following information in some detail. I would also like to meet you in person. A visit enables you to meet our dogs and for us to get to know each other.

- 1) Name, Address, Phone and Email: Reason for wanting a pup (gender/colour preference, flexibility)
- 2) Personal Data: Family details (children, ages, allergies, other animals)
- 3) Home description (location, own or rent, do you have a fenced yard or pen, where will pup stay daytime and night time)
- 4) Work schedules (is someone home to care for the dog, how often alone)
- 5) Previous or present dogs (details, have you owned a Lab/puppy before, have you ever given up a dog)
- 6) Training (have you trained a Lab, are you prepared to attend obedience classes, are you aware that training is an ongoing affair, will you crate your dog)
- 7) Your vets name and phone number and anything else you would like to add.
- 8) Would you allow me access to show a promising dog to its championship? Talk to me about it. I'm easy to work with and respect your ownership.

(*Unless otherwise agreed to, our puppies go home on a registered CKC Non-Breeding Agreement. This helps maintain the breed standard and health history of the purebred Labrador .)
